The European Court of Justice (ECJ)⁶ includes both a Court of First Instance (CFI) since the late 1980s and a Civil Service Tribunal as of 2005 According to Article 220 of the Treaty Establishing the European Community (the "EC Treaty"), the ECJ shall ensure that "the law is observed"
